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Walsall Studio School

Campus development of two schools on the same site. The Ladder School for 112 students provides Key Stage 4 and post-16 education in an industry-led learning environment. Walsall Studio School offers 14–19-yearolds specialist vocational learning.

St Anne's School and Sixth Form

Purpose-built single-storey SEN sixth form school for 115 students, therapeutic centre with sensory facilities and hydrotherapy pool, and an integrated three-storey residential accommodation block of apartments for students, parents, and on-site staff.

Discovery Academy, Sheffield

Simple and sustainable design for a two-storey school for 80 pupils aged 7-16 years with learning difficulties, social, emotional, and mental health needs (SEMH). The building uses natural light and ventilation to create a calm internal environment, connecting to external break-out spaces.

Funded by the DfE Framework, this three-storey steelframed Performing Arts College offers unique specialist teaching provision for 500 students. The 16-19 Free School is a flagship centre of excellence in Arts Education in the North.
